





Joseph Vitale's journey from post-war Italy to Canada began in 1953 when he arrived in Toronto at 15, eager to support his family's dreams. His dedication led to founding Italpasta in 1989, now the largest Canadian-owned pasta manufacturer. Beyond business success, Joe's philanthropy and multicultural initiatives, totaling over \$5 million, have made a significant impact. From co-founding Italia Alimentari Canada to supporting Telelatino Network, his contributions enrich both Canadian and Italian communities. Joe's family takes pride in his legacy of kindness and generosity, knowing he has made countless lives better.



COMMUNITY LEADER

Award

Under Aldo's leadership, TLN's commitment to public service and philanthropy has set an example for all other ethnic media companies in Canada. TLN has provided promotional support to raise millions, and has also financially contributed to dozens of community-based and international charitable organizations, raising funds for various causes – from health-related to natural disaster relief efforts to seniors and children's causes, civic improvement, and cultural projects. One of the more significant financial donations was TLN's \$500,000 support towards the \$13 million naming of the Galleria Italia at the AGO by two dozen Italian Canadian families and organizations.

Aldo Di Felice's contributions have been recognized by various groups over the years. In 2022, the Canadian EthnicMedia Association honoured Aldo for his lifetime achievement in ethnic media.

Aldo has participated in various community association and is a longstanding member of the President's Council at St.

Director, Minimally Invasive Cardiac Surgery at St. Michael's Hospital

Dr. Gianluigi Bisleri joined St. Michael's Hospital in 2021, and shortly there after, became the inaugural director of the Minimally-Invasive Cardiac Surgery (MICS) program, which he established.

A cardiac surgeon trained in minimally-invasive mitral valve repair and atrial arrhythmia surgery, Dr. Bisleri is now providing such care to patients across Ontario. In fact, he's one of the very few cardiac surgeons in the province providing minimally-invasive options to patients with advanced mitral valve disease.

Under Dr. Bisleri's leadership, St. Michael's Hospital is cementing its leadership in mitral valve, atrial fibrillation and other minimally-invasive heart surgeries. This past year, he and his team pioneered a number of national and world firsts: St. Michael's became the first hospital in the country to treat a patient's irregular heartbeat with a procedure carried out on top of the heart, instead of inside of it; we also treated a patient with tricuspid valve disease, with innovations never before used in Canadian hospitals.






